

'Reconnecting the Bible to the Real World' —Ken Ham visits UK 2001

During April Ken Ham made his annual visit to the UK. His 'Reconnecting the Bible to the Real World' tour began with two nights at Gateway International Church in Crawley.

This was followed by a weekend of ministry at Sunderland Free Church and rounded off with two nights at Calvary Chapel, Westminster. In between these meetings Ken spoke to the Christian Police Association both at Cobalt Square, Vauxhall, London, and New Scotland Yard. He also managed to fit in the recording of a radio interview for Premier Christian Radio in London, as well as several interviews to be broadcast on both Sky and Cable TV.

Ken's foundational and confident declaration of the reliability of the Bible and the God of the Bible left his audiences awe-struck. In this sad age, in a society generally convinced that we are all the result of evolutionary processes with the resultant moral and spiritual decline, it was refreshing to hear Ken Ham give reasons for 'Reconnecting the Bible to the Real World'.

His talks began with laying the foundation for the authority of Scripture and ended with the need to use Creation Evangelism, as per the Apostle Paul in Acts 17, to reach our secular world. Other talks dealt with the age of the earth, dinosaurs, and the origin of races—all of them very relevant to the lives of all of us.

Many black people attended the meetings in London. On the last evening, when Ken spoke about the races, the reaction was amazing. Ken says that he has never seen people so moved or so excited. One young man bought six copies of Ken's book, *One Blood*, and got him to autograph them for him. Several

other young black men just kept on shaking Ken's hand and were very emotional and touched by the message which had declared that we are indeed all one blood, made in the image of God.

People left these meetings enthused to go back to their churches with fresh and renewed confidence in their Creator Saviour. Many of them purchased AiG videos to show in Bible

Study Groups or schools. Others went away challenged by the realisation that, as they had been created by an Almighty God who became their Saviour, they are answerable to that God for what they do with their lives.

Wonderful stories are coming in to the AiG office of people who, after all their arguments had been demolished by the messages, are turning to the Lord Jesus Christ. ☐

AiG Ministry in Spain

Ken Ham's recent visit to Valencia came about as a result of a young man who came to faith while an exchange student in America.

After reading Creation magazine and logging on to the AiG website, www.answersingenesis.org, his struggle with evolution ended and he now helps us with various projects, such as translation.

He pleaded with Ken to come to Spain and helped organise ministry in Valencia. Those who attended the meetings were thrilled with the teaching and the fact that there was so much material available in Spanish.

At the first meeting Ken spoke about 'Genesis—the key to understanding and defending Christianity' to a group of about a dozen pastors. One of these pastors was so impressed by this message that he cancelled his evening service and told his congregation to go and listen to Ken Ham—he did this by



putting a notice on his church door! That evening the church was full to overflowing to listen to Ken speak on 'Genesis and the Authority of the Bible'—a message that was well received by everyone who attended.

The church leaders who attended Ken's talks said that the AiG ministry is just what is needed in Spain. They found the relevance message extremely helpful and said that this was the type of evangelism that was needed to reach the Spanish youth. Like all western youth, they are completely indoctrinated by evolutionary philosophy and so do not respond to a 'churchy' Gospel message, as they have no understanding of the origin of sin, death, disease, pain and suffering.

As a result of this visit to Valencia, it looks as though ministry opportunities in Madrid and other large Spanish cities may open up for more AiG ministry in the future.
